

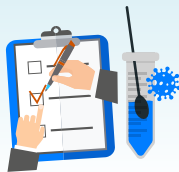
KEY POINTS OF THE SAFE CORRIDOR TO GET TO THE GALAPAGOS

The Ecuadorian authorities recently decided to issue a permit to qualifying tour operators, allowing their passengers to go from mainland Ecuador to the Galapagos Islands without having to comply fully with the mandatory quarantine period currently in place for all international arrivals.

THESE ARE THE NECESSARY STEPS

• Arrival to Ecuador with negative PCR test results + laissez-passer

BEFORE TRAVELING TO MAINLAND ECUADOR



All passengers will have to sign a document agreeing to present the negative results of a COVID-19 PCR test upon arrival of their flight, taken no longer than 7 days before this date.



After arriving, all passengers will be asked to sign a Special Immigration Form agreeing to obey the protocols established by the authorities. Lastly, a Traveler Health Form will need to be signed before disembarking the flight.



In order to avoid the mandatory quarantine period still in place in mainland Ecuador, tourists will also need to show the permit for safe passage (laissez-passer), previously sent by us.



REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVELING FROM THE MAINLAND TO THE GALAPAGOS:



Safe passage permit (laissez-passer) to Galapagos, issued by the tour operator.



Health Insurance.



Return flight from the Galapagos.



PCR-negative test results obtained from a local laboratory.

A second PCR test is required before flying from the mainland to the Galapagos and must be taken a maximum of 4 days before the traveling date. We can provide this service to guarantee a safe and convenient process and ensuring the least downtime possible:

Our certified partner can take the samples at the passengers' place of accommodation and deliver the results after 24 hours, while the passengers remain at their hotels until the results are received. Once all this is obtained, passengers can safely go to Quito or Guayaquil airport in order to travel to the Galapagos.

IMPORTANT!

The flight dates cannot be changed after the laissez-passer has been issued, and it is not possible to have an open return flight date.

Clients booking services independently will need to request an additional laissez-passer directly to the establishment where they are staying, or to the different businesses where services have been booked.
